






Welcome to the Blackbirds Class Newsletter.

We wanted to take this opportunity to let you know what is happening in our class. Below is an outline of some of the different things we will be learning about this half term.

 <p>In Maths we will be focusing on the place value of numbers to 100 and identifying and naming 2D and 3D shapes.</p>	 <p>In English, we will be focusing on sentence structures - joining simple sentences using 'and', 'but' and writing questions. We will use a range of stories and pictures to support our writing.</p>	 <p>In phonics and reading we will continue to practise the words and sounds weekly. For our whole class reading book we will be focusing on 'the day the crayons quit' by Drew Daywalt</p>
 <p>In Science, we will be investigating our five senses - sight, taste, touch, hearing and smell. As scientists we will be collecting information about our environment that are interpreted by the brain.</p>	 <p>In RE, we will be looking at the theme 'Who is Jewish and how do they live'. We will learn about Jewish worldviews and ways of life. They will learn about texts from the Torah and their importance for Jewish people today.</p>	 <p>In Computing we will be exploring online safety and technology around us. We will learn to use technology safely, keeping personal information private; identifying where to go for help and support.</p>
 <p>In PE, we will be learning a range of indoor and outdoor activities, developing co-ordination, teamwork and co-operative skills from our sports coach.</p>	 <p>In geography we will be learning about life in the UK and where this is on a world map. We will focus on the impact this has on climate and seasons then make comparisons to New Zealand.</p>	 <p>In PSCHE we will be learning about how we keep safe using Harold the giraffe and Pantosaurus from the NSPCC to support our learning.</p>
