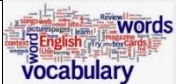


Welcome to the Robins Class Newsletter.

This half term we will be learning all about Kings and Queens! I am excited for the children to explore our castle role play, design and build castles, make crowns, complete a family tree and even re-enact the Royal Coronation!



In Maths we are focussing on numbers 8, 9 and 10. We will be representing, comparing, sorting and investigating the composition of these numbers. We will also be investigating 3D shapes and patterns!



In Literacy, we are focussing on the non-fiction texts Little People Big Dreams for both Queen Elizabeth II and King Charles III. We will also be reading the stories Paddington at the Palace and Katie in London. We will be doing lots of writing based on these!



In Phonics, we are continuing to read and write CVC words and becoming more confident independently reading and writing CVCC and CCVC words. We are building the length of our sentences too and using ? marks!



In RE, we are looking at the Easter story and why Easter is important to Christians. We are very excited to make our own palm leaves and act out Palm Sunday.



In Understanding the World, we will be learning what monarchy means and who is in our Royal family, what the coronation is, where the royal family live and Kings and Queens of the past. We will be ending the term exploring Easter and Spring!



In PE, we are continuing to focus on gymnastics. We will be experimenting with different ways of moving, climbing on different equipment, moving around, over and under different objects and co-ordinating our own short sequences of movement.



In Expressive Arts and Design, we are focussing on junk modelling! We will be learning different ways of joining materials, planning castle designs and constructing them! We will finish the term making Easter bonnets!



In PSED we are learning about our rights and responsibilities and how to be our best selves.
