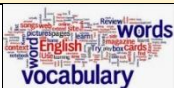

Welcome to the Robins Class Newsletter.
This half term we will be learning all about Spring and How Things Grow!



In Maths we are focussing a lot on comparing numbers to 10, learning number bonds to 10, counting backwards, 3D shape and complex patterns.



In Literacy, we are looking at the fiction texts *What the Ladybird Heard*, *The Extraordinary Gardener* and *Jasper's Beanstalk*. We will also be learning all about non-fiction texts and their features including instructions on how to plant a bean!



In Phonics, we are continuing to read and write CVCC, CCVC and CCVCC words and put them into sentences. We are consolidating our learning of ch, tch, th, sh, ck and double consonants.



In RE, we will be learning about what places are special and why for themselves personally, Christians, Muslims, Jews and Hindus.



In Understanding the World, we will be learning all about farm animals and their young, where food comes from, growing plants and mini-beasts and their habitats. We will be doing lots of gardening, observing and even some bread baking!



In PE, we are learning skills for athletics by taking part in team and individual competitive games and well as learning co-ordination and balance including jumping, throwing, running, relays and obstacle courses.



In Expressive Arts and Design, we are looking at still life art by Van Gogh and creating our own paintings of flowers using a range of mediums such as pastels and watercolours. We will also be creating some mini-beast art by layering paper in the style of Eric Carle in the *Hungry Caterpillar*



In PSED we are learning about growing and changing including life cycles, life stages, getting bigger and that families are all different and special.
