



Collective Worship at Viscount Beaumont's CE School.



Collective worship is a fundamental part of every day in school, worship at Viscount Beaumont happens each morning at 9.05am and starts off our day together. All staff and pupils attend worship.

Our worship focuses on a different theme each week or fortnight and these are organised across the term by our Executive Headteacher Mrs Westaby. You can see the themes in our Collective Worship plan.

Each fortnight one of our classes takes the role of Collective Worship leaders. Their role includes thinking about the theme for the following week, setting out the worship trolley and leading the school in their opening and closing prayers. They also reflect on the worship for their week and feed these back to the senior leadership team and the Christian Ethos Team.

We share what we have been thinking about in Collective Worship with our parents and carers through our fortnightly newsletter and also update our website.

We have been learning and using some new welcoming and blessing prayers, some of these are from different schools in our multi-academy Trust and we have shared the ones we know too. We rotate the prayers we use to open and close Collective Worship every four weeks.

Our school vision is a common thread in our worship time.

We have five Collective Worship sessions a week. We also have an additional Certificate Assembly that takes place on a Friday afternoon where we celebrate children's achievement, attendance, behaviour and our Christian Values.

Parents are invited to attend our Collective Worship once a month along with multiple opportunities to also come into school to celebrate our pupils and for key events throughout the year.
