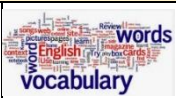

We would like to take this opportunity to let you know what is happening in our class over the next term. Below is an outline of some of the different things we will be learning about this half term.

 Maths Place value In Maths, we will be learning about place value and beginning to develop our addition and subtraction knowledge in our main lessons. We will also be taking part in short mastery number sessions each week to deepen our understanding of number.	 English Sentence structure In English, we will be focusing on correct sentence structure. We will look at how to construct a sentence using a subject and predicate. We will have a strong focus on handwriting and the components needed, such as finger spaces, capital letters and full stops.	 History In History, we will be learning about our local area. We will learn about the similarities and differences of Coleorton in the past and present.	 Art/ DT We will be studying and creating artwork in the style of Henry Rousseau.
 Science In Science we will be looking at how the seasons change throughout the year.	 RE In RE, we will be exploring the question 'Who is a Muslim and how do they live?'	 Computing In Computing, we will be learning about grouping data, as well as talking about internet safety.	 Music This half term, we will be focusing on listening to the beat and rhythm of a variety of songs.

Me and my relationships

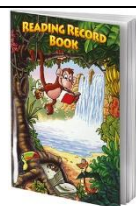
In **PSCHE**, our topic theme will be 'me and my relationships'. We will learn about how to be a good friend and show respect to others and things within our classroom..



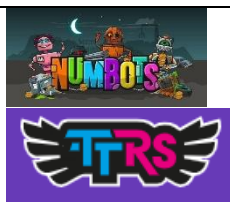
Phonics
