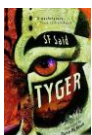

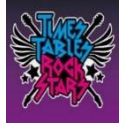

 Maths Place value During this unit, pupils will learn about Roman Numerals, comparing and ordering numbers and strategies when rounding.	 Writing Writing to persuade speech The children will learn how to write a persuasive speech using linking adverbs, subordination and modal verbs.	Reading Tyger by S. F Said We will be reading this magical, thrilling story of two children and a mythical Tyger, set in an alternate London, blending adventure, spirituality, and profound imagination. 	 RE Christianity This unit pupils will be exploring the question: What does it mean if Christians believe God is Holy and loving?
 PE Football and Rugby By learning football and rugby skills will help children develop teamwork, coordination, confidence, and physical fitness while encouraging active and healthy lifestyles.	 History Trafficking of enslaved Africans. We will look at the atrocities of the Transatlantic Slave Trade, looking at how and why the forced migration of millions of Africans took place.	 Computing Computing systems and networks This term pupils, will be learning about the systems that computers use and why some systems are vital when using a computer.	 Science Earth and Space. Children will learn that the universe contains everything in existence, including all the energy and matter that there is.
 Art African Art. Children develop skills in using lines to create their own geometrical and symmetrical patterns inspired by those used on African masks.	 PSHCE Me and my relationships During this unit, pupils will learn about what makes a good friend. And the important role that communication can play.	 French The classroom The children will have the knowledge and skills to present both orally and in written form about what they have and do not have in their pencil cases and/or school bag in French.	 Geography People and population. The children will learn about some of the factors that influence population density and how advancement in health care and industry.
